Abstract

Turning psychiatric research into a succes story? Experiences, pitfalls & results from NESDA

The Netherlands Study of Depression and Anxiety (NESDA) is an ongoing longitudinal, national cohort study in which a large sample of depressed and/or anxious patients is being followed. Over the past 10 years, the NESDA study has yielded several novel insights into the genetic basis, pathophysiology, clinical course trajectory and consequences of depressive and anxiety disorders. Professor Brenda Penninx, principal investigator of NESDA, will talk about some main experiences and pitfalls during 10 years of NESDA research and will highlight some of its central results.
